Shampoo, margarine, shower gel, oven chips, deodorant, bread and ice cream – what do they have in common?
Be a detective – which of your bathroom products contain palm oil?
Non-sustainably managed palm oil is driving climate change – 'Sustainable Palm oil' is key!
Clue – hunt for 'PALM', 'STEAR', 'LAUR', or 'GLYC' – these could mean palm oil!

Over 200 different names are used for labelling palm oil products. These can include: Palmate, Palmitate, Glyceryl, Stearate, Stearic Acid, Palm Stearine, Sodium Lauryl Sulfate, Sodium Kernelate.

Chester, UK, is the world's first 'Sustainable Palm Oil' city!



Look for RSPO certification – 'Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil'.
A boycott would lead to alternatives being grown – which could lead to more destruction. Palm oil trees produce 4-10 times more oil per hectare than soybean, coconut, rapeseed or sunflower oil crops.

Palm oil-driven land use change in Indonesia and Malaysia emits roughly 500 million tonnes of carbon (equivalent) each year, contributing 1.4% of global net emissions.
